

# Urban Combat Pistol

## Memo: Training

Thank you for your interest in my **FREE** offerings for South River Gun Club members. I wanted to share some information on who I am and where this all comes from. I specialize in training Security and Police officers in Firearms and Defensive Tactics. I also have a specialty in Urban Combat Techniques (Which is a cool way of saying city street fighting techniques), whether it be firearm, awareness, self protection, and or any other item related to the protection of self, where it applies to street smarts.

The courses I am putting on demonstrates skills necessary to protect yourself during a real world; Urban (i.e. City) Combat situation. The skills will include:

- First and most important; Safe handling, confidence with, and proper manipulation of your firearm and the correct mindset of a fighting pistol
- Avoiding wasted techniques and/or moves that cost you time during a fight
- Proper sight tracking
- Proper speed shooting to an effective end
- How to properly engage multiple targets
- Fluid movement during shooting
- There will be a lot of myth busting – I teach only the necessary components to ending a gun fight as fast as you can
- Each participant will be pushed to shoot 3 rounds in the upper thoracic in 2 seconds from a concealed position
- We will discuss both dominant hand and reactive hand shooting only
- Proper manipulation of your firearm, with one hand techniques and both
- And more as time allows and skill sets allow, during each session

Each session will awarded to the first 4 students to sign up and will be once, every other month. Dates to be announced. Dates will shift from weekday to weekend days. Times can also vary, based on feedback from club members. Remember this is a **FREE** session to give a better understanding of protection of self and family with your fighting pistol. Participates are asked to wear normal everyday carry clothing, and dress as you would any normal day.

We normally shoot approximately 200 rounds during the session, but the more ammo you bring, the more we can shoot. These will be open forum sessions, that will allow you to pick my brain for any issues you may be encountering and for me to evaluate what you can possibly do to make yourself faster and more accurate.
